## Advent

Advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming." Jesus is coming, and Advent is intended to be a season of preparation for His arrival. While we typically regard Advent as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a period of preparation, much like Lent.

Prayer, penance and fasting are appropriate during this season. Advent is not as strict as Lent, and there are no rules for fasting, but it is meant to be a period of self-preparation. The purple color associated with Advent is also the color of penance. The faithful should fast during the first two weeks in particular and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The color of the Third Sunday of Advent is rose. This color symbolizes joy and represents the happiness we will experience when Jesus comes again. The Third Sunday is a day of anticipatory celebration. It is formerly called "Gaudete" Sunday; gaudete means "rejoice" in Latin.

Finally, Sundays during Advent, just as during Lent, should not be given to fasting, but instead to celebration because we celebrate the resurrection of Our Lord every Sunday. It is important to remember, however, there are no particular rules for how the laity should observe Advent

## Adviento


Adviento viene de la palabra latina que significa "venida". Jesús viene, y Adviento está destinado a ser una temporada de preparación para su llegada. A pesar de que normalmente consideramos Adviento como un tiempo de gozo, sino que también pretende ser un período de preparación, al igual que la Cuaresma. La oración, la penitencia y el ayuno son apropiadas durante esta temporada.

Adviento no es tan estricta como la Cuaresma, y no hay reglas para el ayuno, sino que está destinado a ser un período de auto-preparación. El color púrpura asociado con el Adviento es también el color de la penitencia. Los fieles deben ayunar durante las dos primeras semanas, en particular, y recibir el Sacramento de la Reconciliación.

El color del tercer domingo de Adviento es rosa. Este color simboliza la alegría y representa la alegría que experimentaremos cuando Jesús venga otra vez. El tercer domingo es un día de celebración anticipada. Antiguamente se llamaba "Gaudete" Domingo; gaudete significa "regocijarse" en latín.

Por último, los domingos durante el Adviento, al igual que durante la Cuaresma, en caso de no darse al ayuno, pero en lugar de celebración porque celebramos la resurrección de Nuestro Señor cada domingo. Es importante recordar, sin embargo, no hay reglas específicas sobre cómo los laicos debe observar Adviento
